- What is your sick-child policy and how are health emergencies handled?

- **High Teacher Turnover:** Frequent staff changes can disrupt a child's sense of security and consistency.
- **Lack of Transparency:** Schools should welcome parent questions and offer clear answers about policies and procedures.

- **Unengaged Staff:** Teachers should be actively interacting with children at their eye level, not merely supervising from afar.
- **Overly Rigid Schedules:** Young children need flexibility and plenty of time for unstructured, imaginative play.
